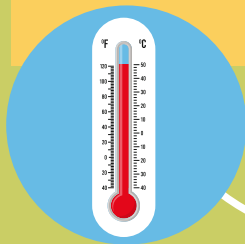
96%

Support for Government Policy

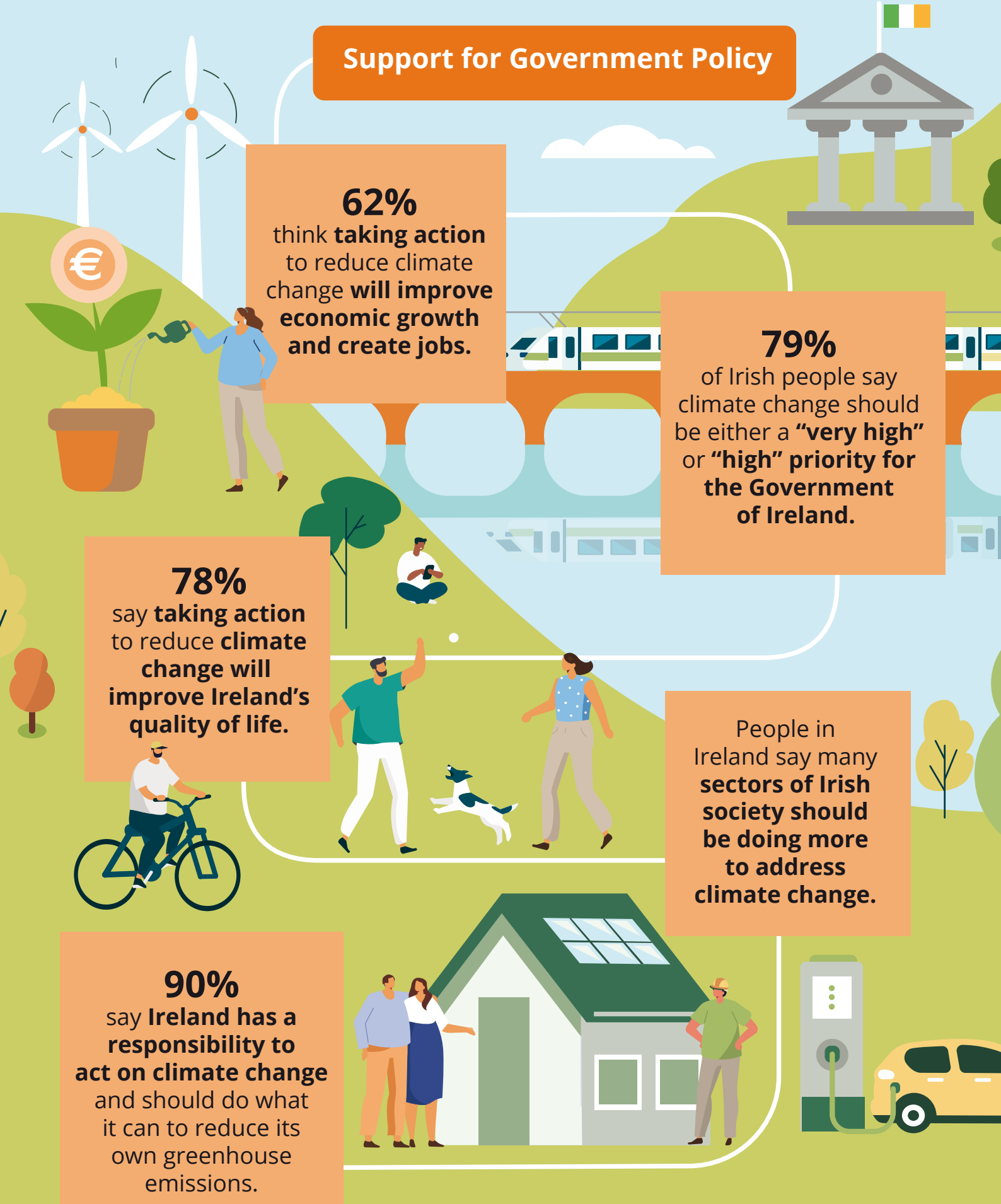
62%

Climate-Related Behaviours

69%
of Irish people would **donate money or volunteer time (60%)** to an **organization working on climate change.**

55%
would **“definitely” or “probably”** or **join a citizens’ campaign** to convince leaders in Ireland **to take action to reduce climate change.**

57%
have **bought goods or services** in the last 12 months from a **company** that has **taken action to reduce climate change.**

52%
would **write letters, email, or phone government officials** about **climate change.**

45%
have **punished companies** in the last 12 months that are **opposing steps to reduce climate change** by not buying their products.
